





need to expand spatial planning towards offshore Sea use planning as tool to prevent conflicts of use in intensively used offshore areas



VASAB Territorial development perspective


- Well integrated and coherent macro-region




BSR MSP Roadmap 2013-20: MSPs throughout the Baltic Sea region by 2020


